

Sewer Committee Meeting December 18, 2007

Clerk verified posting. Motion made/second Gary/Jim to accept the agenda. Carried.

Don – Sewer Report – Don delivered the sewer report, which has been added to the minute book.

Update on bar screening – Kaempfer prepared documents consisting of a couple of options. Booklets will be in minute book. In the draft, the first four pages contain information Kaempfer gathered going over some of the statistics from over the years (peak flows, flows from haulers, etc.). The different plans begin on page 5. Plan FS-1B uses the Raptor, which is similar to the step screen with the bars, only it's got a scraper that fits through them. The scraper goes all the way around the screen. The flow would go through the drum and get caught on the bars and then the scraper goes all the way around. When it gets to the top it brushes it down to the auger, then the auger brings it straight up and washes and dewateres it, then dumps it right into the garbage can or whatever you use. The stuff that comes out is pretty dry. Waupaca is the closest that has this, and it's most likely the cheapest option. Don will call Waupaca to ask about the Raptor and find out how they like it. Committee will look through the information and will meet again on January 15, 2008. Clerk will notify Town Chairman and have him here as well.
