

Sewer Committee/Town Board Meeting June 4, 2007

Paul Kordon called the Sewer Committee/Town Board meeting to order at 5:30PM in the meeting room at the Town Hall on Monday, June 4, 2007. Present James Parent, Robert Schultz, Dale Williams, Paul Kordon, Gary Nelson, Don Prust, Bert Sawyer, Jane Pluff, Doug Smith & Elwyn Kropuenske. James Tishler arrived at 5:45PM. Absent Barb Anschutz & Peter Jacobs.

Clerk verified posting. Motion made/second Paul/Gary to approve agenda. Carried.

Elwyn Kropuenske – Baileys Grove Campground sewer letter to county – Last June he was anticipating selling the campground and had a septic inspection. He had a failing septic system and the town granted approval to hookup the bathroom and the game room to the town sewer at that time. Due to some difficulties with scheduling, plans have changed. Currently Elwyn's intent is to take down the building that contained bathroom and construct new building that would contain living area, game room and office area. He's asking for approval to hook the new living quarters up to the town sanitary system. Preliminary plans would bring it in through the main that currently exists in the campground. Motion made/second Gary/Paul to write a letter to Door County Sanitarian approving Elwyn to hook up his new addition/residence to the Baileys Harbor sewer system. Carried.

Donald Sitte – Immanuel Lutheran Church sewer line update – If the church wants to do this now, the entire project with Ward St./the Catholic Church has to be done now. The town will not share the cost. Also, no matter when it's done, the manhole will have to be deep enough to accommodate the line. Dale is not comfortable giving the estimate that Steve Parent came up with to the Lutheran Church, so he will talk with Steve to come up with something better and we will revisit this issue at a future meeting.

Motion made/second Dale/Paul to enter into Closed Session per State Statutes 19.85 (1) (c) considering employment for part time at treatment plant. Roll call vote Jim Tishler, Dale, Paul, Gary, Bob, Jim Parent, yes. Clerk, Deputy Clerk and both sewer workers were also present.

Motion made/second Dale/Bob to enter back into open session and continue with agenda. Carried.

Discuss/possibly decide on recommendations from Closed Session – Motion made/second Gary/Paul to recommend to the Town Board to hire Ryan Weisgerber for the part time sewer plant operator's position. Carried. Motion made/second Dale/Bob to accept Sewer Committee's recommendation to hire Ryan Weisgerber to be the part time employee at the treatment plant under the direction of Don Prust and Bert Sawyer. Carried. Motion made/second Bob/Dale to give Ryan the wage he left off with and the benefits that the employee manual dictates. Carried.

Motion made/second Dale/Bob to adjourn at 7:00PM. Carried.
