

Town Board Meeting February 19th, 2007

James Parent called the special meeting to order at 6:00 PM in the meeting room at the town hall. Present James Parent, Dale Williams, Peter Jacobs, Barbara Anschutz, Robert Schultz, Jane Pluff, Steve Noel, Dan Segerstrom, Dennis Dettman from the DOT, James Tishler, Paul Kordon, Gary Nelson, Don Prust, Bert Sawyer Clayton Moegenburg, Dennis Hickey, Steven Parent and Eric Gwiat.

Dept. of Transportation discussion on Storm Sewer replacement within the downtown area. - They have moved the resurfacing to 2009. They will let the project out in December 2008 and start in early spring of 2009. The job will be completed by July 4th. They plan on 40 working days to complete. The estimated cost will be \$500,000.00 with the Town's part about \$45000.00. If we want to have more crosswalks in place they will cost about \$600.00 each. This would be added to the estimate cost for the town. On this project they will be billing the town for actual cost and not direct cost. If we want more cross walks will have to apply for permits to the State.

They had a couple of large maps to show where they are intending to place the new storm sewers. They will take some out that are now under buildings. The board asked them if they could consider having the storm sewer from Anclam Park be placed at the town land on the south end of town close to Frogtown road. It would all depend on the grade of the road and land and if the pipes would have plenty of room. If we could have the line at that end it may take care of the problems we have with beach closings etc. Steve Parent will shoot some grades for the town on the property we are considering and be in contact with the DOT.

They were also inform about the sink hole by Ridges Road and where the water does sit. Clayton Moegenburg and Dennis Hickey talk to them about the water that lies behind their places and if that could some how be drained out. The board members talked about maybe placing some pipes further north and try to drain the property instead of asking the DNR for permission to trench.

The DOT must also receive easements for some of the drain pipes. They will be starting soon in asking property owners. They will be coming back for a public informational meeting within the next 6 months.
