

Bike Plan Steering Committee Meeting September 21, 2010

Bryan Nelson called a regular meeting of the Baileys Harbor Bike Plan Steering Committee to order at 5:30PM in the meeting room at the Town Hall. Present were Bryan Nelson, Carol Schmidt and Douglas Smith. David Hansell and James Parent were absent.

Clerk verified posting. Motion made/second Carol/Bryan to accept the agenda. Carried.

Accept minutes – Motion made/second Carol/Bryan to accept the minutes. Carried.

Discussion of Kevin Luecke's (Wisconsin Bicycle Federation rep.) responses to questions that arose at last month's meeting – A copy of the questions and answers are available in the 2010 Minute Book. An item of note was that bike lanes are only allowed in urbanized areas with curb and gutter. We'd like the plan to mention if they ever would become allowable, we'd like to see all of Hwy. 57 have them. Also, we will find out if other rural towns in Wisconsin are asking for bike lanes on state highways. In reviewing Kevin's responses, it was determined that Summit and Logerquist Roads should be added to the plan.

Discussion of bicycle facility maps prepared by Kevin Luecke of the Wisconsin Bicycle Federation and discuss the proposed recommendations and facility guidance and determine if changes are needed – The Committee reviewed the maps alongside the list of routes in the actual plan. It was decided to add the following routes:

-County Hwy E going west from county Hwy A to the West Town Border.

-Honold Rd going west from County Hwy A to the West Town Border.

-The entire length of Summit Rd.

-Logerquist Rd going south from County Hwy E to the South Town Border.

The committee then reviewed the rest of the provided information. As with the last meeting, Bryan will send a list of questions and changes to Doug, who will then forward it to Kevin.

Motion made/second Bryan/Carol to adjourn at 6:24PM. Carried.
