

Sewer Committee Meeting January 24, 2011

Paul Kordon called the regular monthly Sewer Committee meeting to order at 6:00PM in the meeting room at the Town Hall. Present were Paul Kordon, James Anschutz, Douglas Smith, Donald Prust, Bert Sawyer, Ryan Weisgerber and 1 visitor.

Clerk verified posting. Motion made/second Paul/Jim to accept the agenda. Carried.

Accept minutes – Motion made/second Jim/Paul to accept the minutes. Carried.

Accept Treasurer Report – Motion made/second Paul/Jim to accept the report. Carried.

Citizen input – None.

Discuss/decide quote from Kaempfer & Associates to evaluate capacity at lift stations 6 & 7 – The pumps would be evaluated to see if they need to be bigger. DNR dictates that the pumps would have to be engineered, so this is the first step of the process. Cost would be \$1,300 per lift station, for an estimated total of \$2,600 for the study. If they need to be upgraded, the new pumps would have to be approved by the DNR. Motion made/second Paul/Jim to accept the quote. Carried.

Update on new truck purchase – Truck will be in later this week. It will then go to Green Bay for the hoist installation and to Crivitz for the plow installation after that.

Update on Chapel Lane drainage issues, if available – No new updates from the engineer, but Roy Cole expressed concerns about whether the DNR would allow the proposed fix. Paul explained that everything would have to be DNR approved before any work is done.

Don Prust – Sewer Report – Don delivered the report, a copy of which is available upon request. Motion made/second Jim/Paul to accept the report. Carried.

Motion made/second Paul/Jim to adjourn at 6:30PM. Carried.
