

Town Board Meeting March 10, 2011

Clerk verified posting. Motion made/second Peter/Roberta to accept the agenda. Carried.

Finalize annual mailing and informational mailing regarding the Core Area referendum question – Clerk presented drafts of the postcard being mailed to out-of-town addresses and the full annual report being mailed to in-town addresses. The full report will still be checked for typos/errors, but the Board felt both items were fine to send out. The discussion then turned to the mailing regarding the Core Area and Jim Parent excused himself to the audience. Some minor corrections were made with spacing issues and verbiage, but overall the document looks good. Peter brought up whether or not it should be mentioned somewhere that the reason for looking at extending to this area was to accommodate businesses of larger size footprints. After some discussion, it was decided to leave the information as-is. Motion made/second Roberta/Bob to accept the design and verbiage of the informational sheet on the referendum as presented with the few minor corrections discussed. Carried, with Jim Parent abstaining. Clerk will have the letter incorporated into the Annual Report. Michael Meulemans donated his time in designing, formatting and doing the layout for all three items discussed this evening.

Motion made/second Bob/Peter to adjourn at 6:18PM. Carried.
