

Town Board Meeting April 25, 2012

Donald Sitte called a special Town Board meeting to order at the intersection of Chapel Lane and Frogtown Road. Present were Donald Sitte, Robert Schultz, Barbara Anschutz, Roberta Thelen, Peter Jacobs, Douglas Smith, Steve Parent and about 15 visitors.

Clerk/Administrator verified posting. Motion made/second Barb/Roberta to accept the agenda. Carried.

Question and answer session in regards to the Chapel Lane reconstruction project – The Town Board, Town Clerk/Administrator and Town Engineer walked the road with residents and property owners and answered questions along the way. The paved area of the road is currently twelve feet wide. The original plan called for increasing the paved area to 18 feet with 2 foot shoulders on each side for a total of 22 feet. Bob explained that storm water runoff could be greatly improved if the road was made 20 feet wide with a foot shoulder on each side. The width of the overall road would remain the same. After discussion, it was determined that a 20 foot road with 1 foot shoulders was the way to go. The shoulders will be top soil rather than gravel. The Town Board then continued to walk down the road with property owners to address individual property owners' concerns. Several items such as storm water runoff, saving of trees and right-of-way locations, were discussed. As the project is progressing, the contractor and engineer will work to address property owners' needs whenever possible, and every step will be taken to maintain the character of the road.

Motion made/second Roberta/Peter to adjourn at 7:11PM. Carried.
