

ORDINANCE 4-96

This Ordinance is entitled the Town of Baileys Harbor Public Building and Public Lands Ordinance.

The Town Board of the Town of Baileys Harbor has the specific statutory authority, powers and duties, not let any domestic animal run at large on/in Town Property/Buildings.

The Town Board of the Town of Baileys Harbor does not permit access to or use of any Town of Baileys Harbor Public Buildings and the Town of Baileys Harbor Public lands by any cat, dog or other domestic animal except as follows:

- a. Seeing Eye dog or other animal used to assist the visually handicapped.
- b. A dog, cat or other domestic animal with a motor vehicle where the animal is in the motor vehicle by consent of the owner of the motor vehicle.
- c. A dog, cat or other domestic animal is permitted and authorized by the Town Board of the Town of Baileys Harbor as an authorized animal of a Fair, Circus or other social event that has been authorized to be held on land owned or leased by the Town Board of the Town of Baileys Harbor.

Violation. Each violation of this ordinance shall result in a forfeiture of not less than \$25.00 or more than \$250.00 plus all cost incurred by the town.

Effect. This ordinance takes effect upon passage at the town board meeting.
