

TOWN OF BAILEYS HARBOR
RECYCLING PROGRAM INSTRUCTIONS
(For recyclables generated in the Town of Baileys Harbor)

WHERE: April 10th through October 31st: Baileys Harbor Recreational Park
2623 (Stieglitz) Summit Road

November 1st through April 9th: Baileys Harbor Fire Station
2404 Park Road

TIME: 10:00 AM to 1:00 PM
2nd and 4th Saturday of every month.

CHECK WITH ATTENDANT BEFORE YOU UNLOAD YOUR ITEMS:

Items should be prepared and sorted prior to arrival; this will prevent lines and delays at the drop site. IMPROPERLY PREPARED RECYCLABLES WILL BE REFUSED.

The following recyclables will be accepted commingled:

- 1- Tin & Bimetal Cans
- 2- Aluminum Cans
- 3- Glass (bottles and jars)
- 4- Plastic bottles with necks (coded #1 or #2)
- 5- Metal caps and lids, Aluminum foil and pie tins

The following recyclable PAPER PRODUCTS will be accepted commingled:

- 1- Newspaper & Inserts
- 2- Office paper, junk mail and envelopes
- 3- Magazines, catalogs, phone books and all books
- 4- Grocery bags
- 5- Residential & commercial cardboard

HOW TO PREPARE MATERIAL FOR DROP OFF SITE

Tin & bimetal cans: Rinse cans completely free of all food. Food and beverage cans should be recycled. NOT ACCEPTABLE: Aerosol cans, paint cans, pots, pans, nails, screws, car parts, or sheet metal.

Aluminum beverage cans: rinse cans.

Glass: (Colorless, brown, green or other transparent colors). Only unbroken glass food and beverage containers will be accepted. Remove all plastic or metal collars, rings and throw in garbage. Metal caps can be recycled as tin. Rinse containers. Paper labels do not have to be removed. NOT ACCEPTABLE: Ceramic cups, plates, bottle tops, clay flower

pots, drinking glasses, crystal, plate glass, auto windshields, opaque/milk glass, laboratory glass, light bulbs, ovenware, window glass.

Plastic Containers: Includes soda bottles, distilled water, milk orange juice, bleach jugs. Look on the bottom of the plastic containers. Most of them have a symbol with a number inside the symbol. If you find a #1 or #2 inside the recycling symbol you can recycle this container. (Except where noted as not acceptable). Remove all collars, caps lids, rings and throw in garbage. Rinse containers. Labels do not have to be removed.

NOT ACCEPTABLE: Motor oil bottles, bottles with codes 3 through 7 caps, lids, Styrofoam, microwave containers, solvent, paint, adhesive containers, medical supplies, plastic toys, flower pots, garden plastics, pesticide or herbicide containers, all plastic bags (even those with #2 code) yogurt and cottage cheese containers, antifreeze bottles.

Metal caps & lids, aluminum foil and pie tins: Rinse clean, compact foil into ball and recycle.

PAPER PRODUCTS

Newspaper/inserts: The newspapers need not be bundled. You may put them in a bag or box.

Office paper/junk mail/envelopes

Magazines/catalogs/phone books/all books.

Residential, commercial Corrugated Cardboard and boxboard

NOT ACCEPTABLE: tissue products, frozen food or dairy container boxes.

Paper products must be dry and free of food debris.
